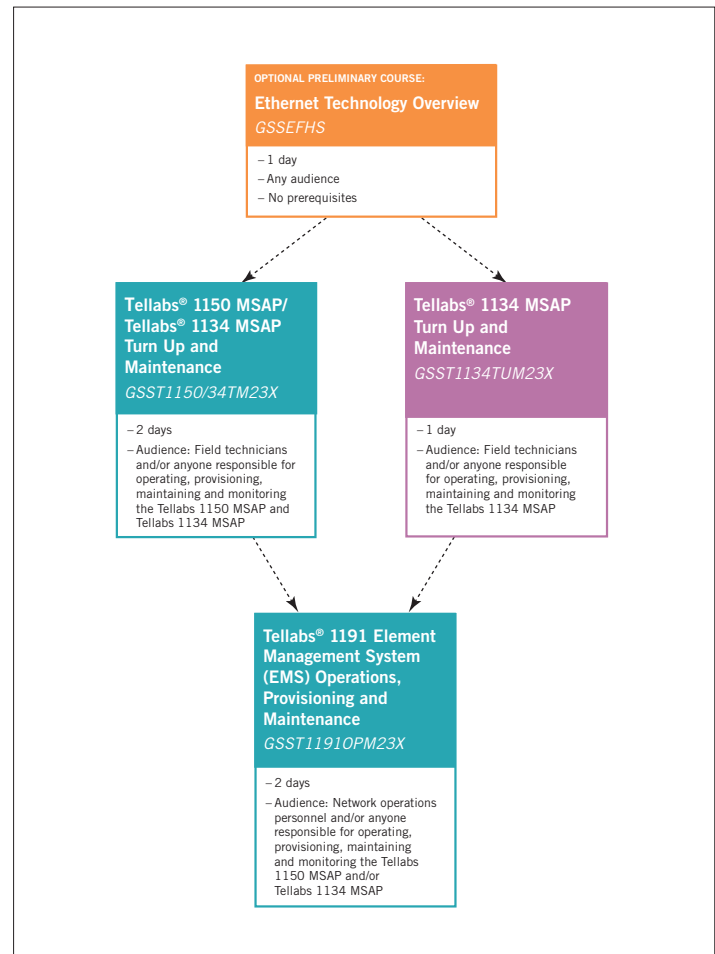


Figure 1. Tellabs 1100 Multiservice Access Series training curriculum
